



How do I become a member?

Any interested person over the age of 18, and all married persons regardless of age can become a member.

1. Submit an application to the Welcoming Chairperson stating intention of joining.
2. Attend three (3) business meetings within a six (6) month period after submission of application.
3. Submit, to the club treasurer, the \$20.00 initiation fee and dues to the end of the year. Annual dues are \$36.00 (which includes yourself, spouse and children within your household) and a current copy of your homeowner's/renter's insurance.
4. Acceptance, by secret ballot, by two-thirds (2/3) of the voting membership present.
5. Notification by mail regarding acceptance, membership effective on the first (1st) of the month following notification. Applicants not accepted will receive a refund of the initiation fee and dues by return mail.
6. Children of active members may request continuance of their membership by submitting an application to the Welcoming Chairperson and following the same procedures as new members in 3, 4 and 5. No initiation fee requested.
