

SHOW RULES

Decisions of the Show chairperson are final

- * USEF gymkhana rules will be used as guidelines.
 - * No running horses in the parking lot. Use warm-up area only.
 - * All dogs must be kept on a leash.
 - * No bike riding on grounds during the show.
 - * No verbal harassment towards riders, spectators or TLRC members.
 - * Stallions may not be handled by anyone under 18 y.o.
 - * No abuse to animals or people.
 - * Helmets are required for all riders under 18 years old
 - * Events with less than 3 entries may be combined or Cancelled.
 - * No refunds unless obvious injury to horse and/or rider.
 - * Only adults 18 and over can assist young riders in lead line classes.
 - * Cross-entering is allowed and points are accumulated by the same horse/rider combination.
- The parking lot is for vehicles with horse trailers and vehicles of riders without trailers only. Please park all other vehicles outside of the parking lot roadside on Excelsior Ave.

2-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced unless there is a tack change on file with sign-up booth. If you miss your class, class fees are forfeited.

All class and rider changes must be made at sign-up booth. Additions to classes will be accepted up to the start of 1 class before your desired event (i.e. when class #2 starts, class #3 is closed).

If you wish to scratch a class, please inform the sign-up booth. There is no refund for scratched classes.

For the safety of all participants, horses out of control may be requested to leave the arena or show grounds.

Riders are responsible for entering classes appropriate for age.

HIGH POINT OF THE DAY RULES

POINTS ARE BASED ON SAME HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION

RIDERS MUST BE PRESENT WHEN HIGH POINT IS ANNOUNCED TO WIN

HIGH POINT PLACEMENT CHART

1st PLACE 2nd PLACE 3rd PLACE 4th PLACE 5th PLACE
10 POINTS 8 POINTS 6 POINTS 4 POINTS 2 POINTS

All 6 events per show count towards high point. Jackpot classes do not count towards high point.
