Show Rules

Decisions of the Show Chairperson are Final

- U.S. Equestrian rules will be used as guidelines.
- No running horses in the parking lot. Use warm-up area only
- All dogs must be kept on a leash
- Bike riding on grounds are not permitted during the show
- Verbal harassment towards riders, spectators, or TLRC members will not be tolerated
- Stallions may not be handled by anyone under 18 years of age
- Abuse to animals or people will not be tolerated
- Helmets are required for all riders
- Events with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled; TLRC reserves the right to do so
- No refunds unless obvious injury to horse and/or rider
- Only adults 18 and over can assist young riders in lead line classes
- Points for high point (when offered) are accumulated by the same horse/rider combination. Cross entering is allowed but will be scored separate for each horse/rider combination

The parking lot is for vehicles with trailers only. Please park all vehicles without a trailer outside of the parking lot roadside on Excelsior Ave.

Required Attire, English: boots, breeches, belt, helmet, English shirt or polo shirt, (shirts must be tucked in), jacket. (Judge can make decision regarding jackets in hot weather)

ATSM/SEI approved helmet required whenever on horse on show grounds

2-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced unless there is a tack change on file with sign-up booth. If you miss your class, class fees are forfeited

All class and rider changes must be made at sign-up booth. Additions to classes will be accepted up to the start of 2 classes before your desired class (i.e. when class #12 starts, class 14 is closed)

If you wish to scratch a class, please inform the sign-up booth. There is no refund for scratched classes. Entries will not be traded for another class

For the safety of all participants, horses out of control may be requested to leave the arena or show grounds

Riders are responsible for entering classes appropriate for age
